### **Cameron Grebe**

Mr Grebe is Head of Division (Environment) at the National Offshore Petroleum Safety and Environmental Management Authority (NOPSEMA). NOPSEMA is Australia's regulator for health and safety, well integrity and environmental management of offshore petroleum activities in Commonwealth waters and designated state/Northern Territory waters

Since commencing in August 2011, Mr Grebe has led the transition of NOPSEMA to include the regulation of environmental management, involving a comprehensive stakeholder engagement and streamlining program. He is responsible for leading NOPSEMA's regulatory oversight of petroleum activity environmental management, including oil pollution risk management and emergency planning.

Mr Grebe has extensive international experience in ecological and social impact issues within the resources sector. Prior to joining NOPSEMA, Mr Grebe worked at Woodside Energy and Shell Global Solutions International for 12 years as an environmental engineer, adviser and manager of environmental impact assessment of upstream exploration and production and LNG projects.

Mr Grebe continues to influence improved environmental outcomes in his current role.
