Dayne Maxwell is the Marine Pollution Response Service Planning Leader, and a National On-Scene Commander, for Maritime New Zealand, which he joined in 2001. Dayne's main work within MPRS involves maintaining the National Marine Oil Spill Contingency Plan, assisting the Regional Councils with reviewing and updating their Regional Marine Oil Spill Contingency Plans, assessing and approving oil spill contingency plans for New Zealand's offshore oil exploration and production activities, as well as assisting NZ's PACPLAN countries in building their oil spill response capabilities including the development and maintenance of their National Oil Spill Contingency Plans.

During his time with Maritime New Zealand, Dayne has also been actively involved in all areas of MPRS including, response planning, training and exercising. He was involved in the Jody F Millennium and the Tai Ping oil spill responses in 2002, attended the Global Peace spill in Gladstone, Queensland 2006, the Forum Samoa II grounding in Apia, Samoa 2009, the Gulf of Mexico spill in 2010 and the Rena spill in the Bay of Plenty in 2011.
