Greg DeMarco currently serves as ExxonMobil's Global Emergency Preparedness & Response Manager. In that role, he leads a team that coordinates tactical- and strategic-level support for the Corporation's preparedness and response efforts to a variety of hazards. Greg also interfaces with response organizations, trade associations, and government agencies and oversees ExxonMobil's oil spill response R&D program.
