This includes undertaking assessment and inspection of oil spill monitoring plans that are required for all offshore petroleum activities in NOPSEMA's jurisdiction. Janelle leads the strategic development of oil spill monitoring preparedness for NOPSEMA including liaison with industry, and state and Commonwealth government agencies. Janelle also provides specialist technical advice to working group members for Australia's National Plan for Maritime Environmental Emergencies
