Mr. Lin Xiangbin, born in January 1981, graduated from the Marine Engineering Major of Dalian Maritime University in 2005, and subsequently joined Shanghai Maritime Safety Administration, began to focus on the control and emergency response of pollution from ships since 2009. Now he works as a section chief in the Department of Dangerous Goods Control and Pollution Prevention from Ships, Shanghai MSA.

Mr. Lin once took part in the drafting of Regulations on Administration of the Prevention and Control of Marine Environment Pollution from Ships, also was in charge of the drafting of the new version of the Shanghai Exclusive Emergency Plan for Marine Pollution Accidents from Ships.

He went through the emergency response to some significant pollution accidents from ships in recent years, such as M.V. MAXIMA in 2012, M.V. CMA CGM FLORIDA in 2013, M.T. SANCHI in 2019, etc.

Mr. Lin is also in charge of the implementation of Domestic Emission Control Area policy in Shanghai, to build a better and cleaner Shanghai port.
